Reasons these courses are **vital** to you and your family:

Adult Sessions (18+ yrs.): Come and expand on your budgeting and saving skills. Find out where your personal financial skills came from. Learn about interest rates, how credit collections work, ways to improve credit, etc., In addition, various homeownership opportunities will be shared for those interested and on-going homeownership guidance may be provided.

Youth (17yr. -13yr.): Will learn the importance of earning, saving, developing a budget, and how to build and maintain good credit. They will also learn about credit cards, loans, etc., and how it will effect their future.

Children (12yr. -8yr.): Will learn and be able to start the beneficial skill of saving, Children will also learn differences between wants vs. needs and other aspects of finances so they are aware of the financial obligations of their family.
